Dear Mr. Bertram and Ms. Wilkins,

This letter is to inform you that SkyLink Airways, Inc. ("SkyLink") has received confirmation from the Secretary of State of the State of Delaware of SkyLink's name change to MAXjet Airways, Inc. ("MAXjet").

As SkyLink indicated in earlier filings, it has been the Company's intention to choose a new name prior to completion of certification. The new name complies with trademark requirements in the US and certain other key countries and also meets the Company's marketing needs. SkyLink has advised the FAA of the change and asked that the FAA Operating Certificate be issued in the name of MAXjet Airways, Inc.

This name change completes the agreement discussed in the SkyLink Show Cause Order, Footnote 3 to Order 2005-1-1, issued on January 5, 2005. At this time SkyLink Airways, Inc. is in the process of notifying its vendors of the name change.

SkyLink respectfully requests that the name change to MAXjet Airways, Inc. be made effective immediately. In accordance with 14 CFR § 215.4, SkyLink Airways, Inc. respectfully re-registers for its initial operating authority under the name MAXjet Airways, Inc. Effective with the completion of the DOT registration, the "SkyLink" name will not be used for any future corporate, marketing or other purpose.

The Company will file a Montreal Agreement with the new name.
